WHEREAS by the *Port Regulations*, 1923 (Statutory Rules No. 20 of 1923), as now amended it is provided that the said Regulations shall apply to and have effect in such other Ports as the Lieutenant-Governor by Proclamation published in the *Gazette* may proclaim:

Now, therefore, I, the Lieutenant-Governor aforesaid, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the powers vested in me, do hereby proclaim and declare that the *Port Regulations*, 1923, as from time to time amended shall apply to and have effect in the Port of Daru as defined in the Proclamation⁽²⁾ published in the *Gazette* of the ninth November, 1893.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the said Territory, at Port Moresby, this sixth day of November, in the year of Our Lord, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, and in the first year of His Majesty's reign.
