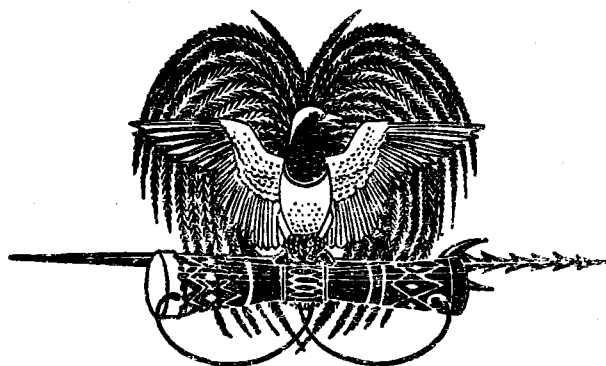

Town Planning Act 1952-1972

VARIATION OF ZONING OF TOWNS

THE Town Planning Board, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 7 of the *Town Planning Act 1952-1972*, and all other powers it enabling, hereby gives notice of the variation of the zoning of the towns specified in the first column of the schedule hereto and declares that each area depicted in a plan as a Special Use Zone is a Special Use Zone for the purposes of that Act.
