Organic Law on National Elections

BALLOT-PAPER

THE ELECTORAL COMMISSION, by virtue of the powers vested in it by Section 10(1) of the Electoral Regulation and all other powers it enabling, certifies that, whereas in the elections in the electorates set out in the Schedule hereunder, there were at the time of nomination more than one but not more than fifteen candidates—

- (a) each of the candidates in the elections in the said electorates has supplied a photograph approved by the Electoral Commission as being suitable for reproduction on a ballot-paper; and
- (b) it is practicable to use, in the election, ballot-papers in Form 17 including photographs of each of the candidates.

Accordingly, the ordinary ballot-papers to be used in the elections in the said electorate shall be in Form 17 including a photograph of the head of each of the candidates taken from the photographs supplied, positioned as shown on that form.
