WATER SUPPLY SCHEMES AT LAE, WEWAK AND MOUNT HAGEN

PREQUALIFICATION OF CIVIL ENGINEERING CONTRACTORS

The Government of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea intends to construct water supply schemes at Lae, Wewak and Mount Hagen. The civil engineering construction works will be carried out under nine separate contracts and tender documents will be issued to prequalified contractors between September, 1978 and October, 1979. The cost of any single contract is expected to be between K300 000 and K2 800 000.

The works will comprise the construction of:

- Headworks
- Reservoirs and trunk mains
- Laying of reticulation mains

Tenderers must show that they have sufficient financial resources and technical experience to undertake the contracts.

The foreign exchange costs of the contracts is intended to be financed from a loan of special funds resources of the Asian Development Bank. To permit such financing, each contract must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- (1) The contractor must be a national of an eligible source country;
- (2) The services supplied under the contract must be wholly or substantially supplied from an eligible source country or countries; and
- (3) Any materials and equipment supplied by the contractor under the contract must be produced in an eligible source country or countries.

For purposes of these requirements, the term 'eligible source country' means any member country of the Asian Development Bank, other than France.

Prequalification to tender for construction of headworks will be open to contractors from all eligible source countries as described above.

Prequalification to tender for the construction of reservoirs and pipelines will be limited to contractors with offices registered in Papua New Guinea.
