CONSTITUTION

DETERMINATION OF RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS IN RELATION TO ADMINISTRATION OF LEGISLATION

I, Michael Thomas Somare, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148(1) of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby—

- (a) revoke all previous notices of Determination of Responsibilities of Ministers in Relation to Administration of Legislation; and
- (b) determine that each Minister specified in Column 2 of a Schedule shall have the responsibility for administering the provisions specified opposite that Minister in Column 1.
