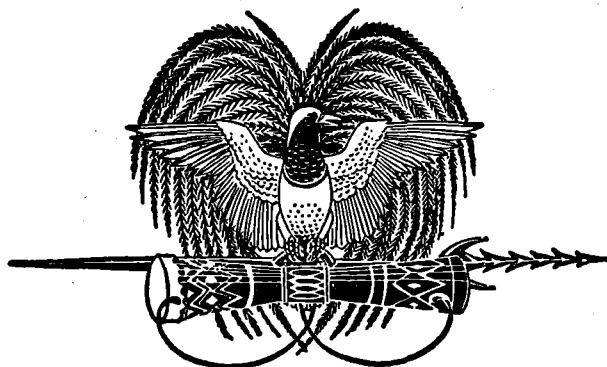

Banks and Financial Institutions Act 1973

DECLARATION OF NON-BUSINESS DAY

I, Barry Blyth Holloway, Minister for Finance, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 29 of the *Banks and Financial Institutions Act 1973* and all other powers me enabling and being of the opinion that it is in the public interest that banks should remain closed on each Saturday for the period commencing on and from 22nd July, 1978 up to and including 12th August, 1978, hereby declare each of those days to be a non-business day for banks.
