**CONSTITUTION****APPOINTMENT OF MINISTER UNDER SECTION 95(5) OF THE CONSTITUTION**

I, Tore Lokoloko, G.C.M.G., O.B.E., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 95(5) of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting on the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby—

- (a) revoke all previous appointments of Ministers to exercise and perform the powers, functions, duties and responsibilities of the Governor-General when neither the Speaker nor the Chief Justice is available (or, in the case of the Chief Justice, qualified) to be the Acting Governor-General; and
- (b) appoint Paul Torato, a Minister, to exercise and perform the powers, functions, duties and responsibilities of the Governor-General, whenever—
  - (i) there is a vacancy in the office of Governor-General; or
  - (ii) the Governor-General is suspended from office; or
  - (iii) the Governor-General is—
    - (a) on leave of absence; or
    - (b) absent from the country; or
    - (c) out of speedy and effective communication; or
    - (d) otherwise unable to perform, or is not readily available to perform the duties of his office; and
  - (iv) neither the Speaker nor the Chief Justice is available (or, in the case of the Chief Justice, qualified) to be the Acting Governor-General.
