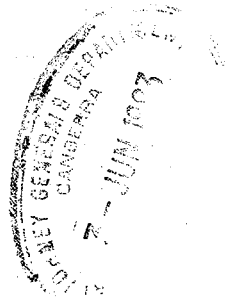

## PROPOSED WORK PROGRAMME AND ANTICIPATED EXPENDITURE

Although a work programme is given for 2 years, this can only be an estimate as it will depend to a large extent on the results achieved in 1 year.

## YEAR 1—

1. *Objective*

- To assess the ore reserves of all of the small mines in the Astrolabe Mineral Field; and
- To evaluate the potential of anomalies previously discovered by earlier geophysics; and
- To co-ordinate exploration with the development of the Laloki Deposit.

Application for a Prospecting Authority—*continued*2. *Geological Investigations to be conducted.*

- In the light of the early success of the Sirosimelt process to the development of the Laloki ore body, exploration work should be directed toward the reassessment of the numerous, small, worked ore bodies within the Astrolabe Mineral Field. These now default mines include the Federal Flag, Moresby King, Sapphire, Merrie England, Sapphire King, Ruby, Dubuna, Mt. Diamond Elvina South and the Pari. This work should be directed particularly toward ascertaining the extent, if any, of reserves remaining in these mines; and

This work would involve a view of the literature available pertaining to each mine, geological mapping, surface sampling, costeening, trenching and shallow percussion drilling. It may also involve gaining access to the mines to collect samples and programmes.

- The second major exploration effect should be directed towards the testing of the anomalies found during the EMP study carried out by Newmont Pty. Ltd. A programme of three (3) diamond drill holes is proposed to test the southern strike extension of the Dubuna and Anomaly D, 700 metres to the south thereof.

The grid positions, azimuth, angle and proposed depths of each hole are given in the accompanying document.

3. *Cost Estimate:*

- Evaluation of old mines K20 000
- Evaluation of Geophysical anomalies K50 000  
(Added to this the on going feasibility studies pertaining to the development of the Laloki Deposit which to date have amounted to K25 000 and expected to cost a further K30 000 in next 6 months).

4. *Time Duration*

It is estimated a time of approximately six (6) months would be required to carry out the work outlined plus additional time to assess results and write up report.

## YEAR 2—

Assuming the results from Year 1 were satisfactory and encouraging, a programme of further drilling to outline the extent of discoveries made during Year 1 would be conducted. This involve splitting of mineralised diamond ore for assay, plotting of information on both plans and sections followed by ore reserve estimations.

The cost of such work can not be ascertained until the results of Year 1 are to hand.
