Customs (Tariff) Act (Chapter 101A)

EXEMPTION FROM EXPORT DUTY

I, JOHN GIHENO, Acting Minister for Finance and Planning, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9 of the *Customs (Tariff) Act* (Chapter 101A) as amended by the *Customs (Tariff) (Amendment No. 2) Act* 1986 and all other powers me enabling, and being satisfied that it is in the interest of the particular industries to do so, hereby exempt from export duty the class of goods shown in Column 3 of the Schedule for a period commencing on and from 1st February, 1989 up to and including 30th April, 1989.
