AMENDMENT TO NATIONAL CAPITAL DISTRICT RETAIL SALES TAX LAW 1990

The purpose of this submission is to seek Commission approval to amend the following provisions of the National Capital District Retail Sales Tax Law 1990:

Section 6 in relation to imposition of tax on cigarettes and tobacco products. The present tax is 2%. In the amendment 2% will be charged on the manufacturer and 2.5% charged on the wholesaler or retailer at the retail level to bring the overall tax to 4.5% from last years tax which was 3%. This is in line with current understanding between the Commission and the cigarettes and tobacco manufacturers.

Repeal and replacement of Section 10. A new Section 10(a) is to be included to cater for the exemption application form which is a prescribed form required by Section 5(1)b of the National Capital District Government (Preparatory Arrangements) (Retail Sales Tax) Regulation 1983. The numbering of the form for a Certificate of Exemption will be changed from the current Form 3 to Form 4.

Amendment to Schedule 1. Schedule 1 of the Retail Sales Tax Law 1990 will be amended to include a new form for application for exemption. To be in order, the present Form 3 will become Form 4 and the new form for application for exemption will be Form 3 in the Schedule.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the Commission debate and pass this new law as contained in the Bill for the proposed amendment, namely, the Retail Sales Tax (Amendment) Bill 1990.

It is recommended that the Commission approve that the requirement for publication under Section 6(1) of the National Capital District Government (Preparatory Arrangements) Regulation 1983 be dispensed with.

EXPLANATIONS AND CONSIDERATIONS

The amendments are self-explanatory. Apart from the cigarettes and tobacco tax which is to give effect to the current understanding between the Commission and that industry the other amendments are basically technical requirements to give effect to the Retail Sales Tax Law 1990.

The provisions that need to be amended are contained in the draft Bill which will be forwarded to the Minister for Provincial Affairs for approval before publication in the *National Gazette* once it is approved by the Commission.

The main purpose of this submission is the Retail Sales Tax (Amendment) Bill 1990. The new Form 3 for application for exemption is also attached.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

As discussed above.

BUDGETARY IMPLICATIONS

In line with the 1990 budget approved by the Commission. The budget will not be affected.

NOTIFICATION OF REGISTRATION OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS

Eng.' after their names. It is an offence under the Act for a Statutory body, Government body, or Organisation which employs an unregistered person to employ an unregistered person. An unregistered person who practises as a professional engineer is guilty of an offence. Applications for exemption from registration and the provisions of the Act may be made.
