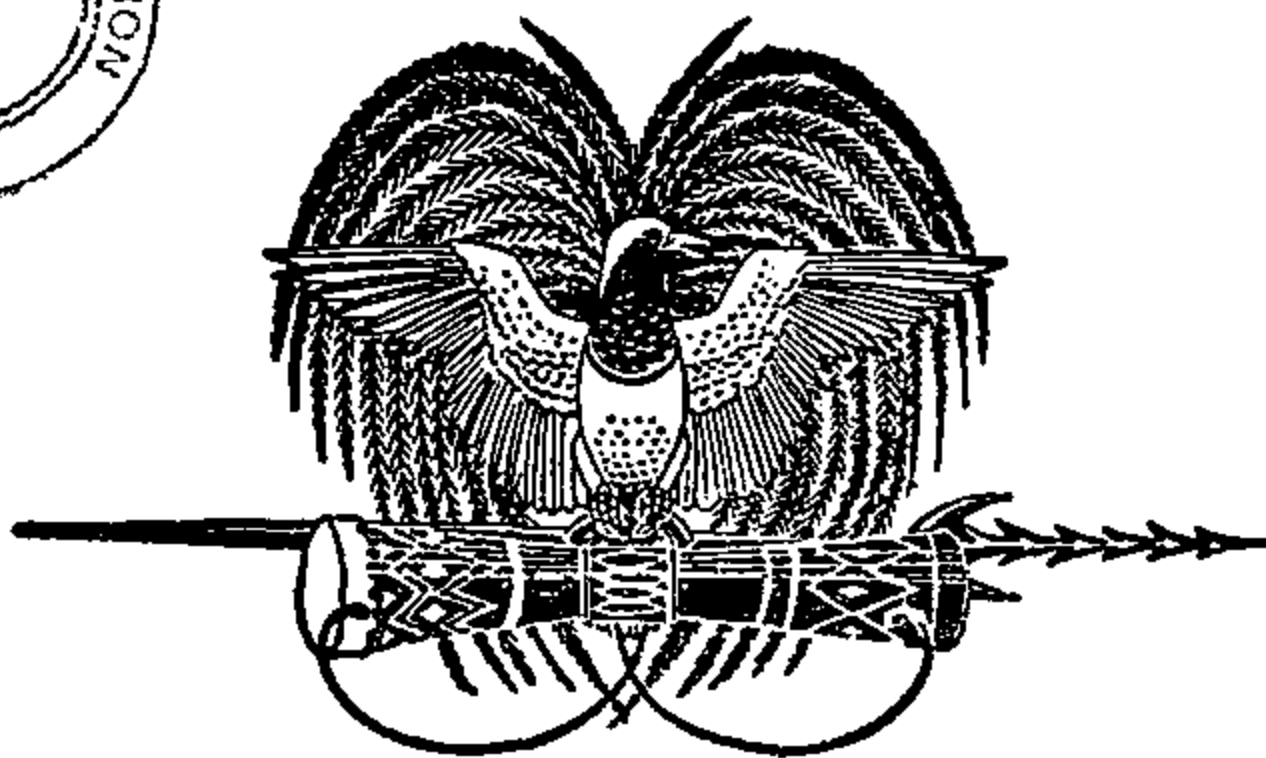
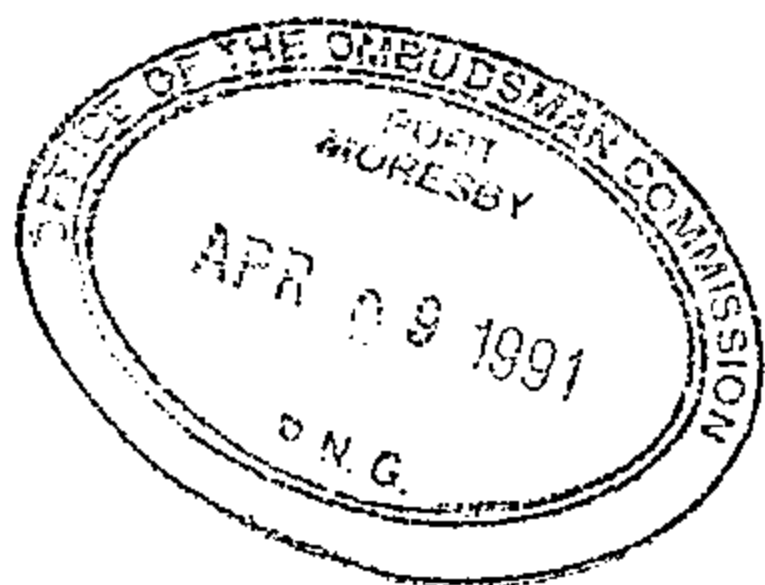

PROCLAMATION OF CURFEW

I, SEREI ERI, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the *Curfew Act 1987* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby require every person within the boundaries of Western Highlands Province to remain within doors between the hours of eight o'clock in the evening (8 p.m.) and five o'clock in the morning (5 a.m.) for a period of two months commencing on and from eight o'clock in the evening (8 p.m.) on Friday, 5th April, 1991.
