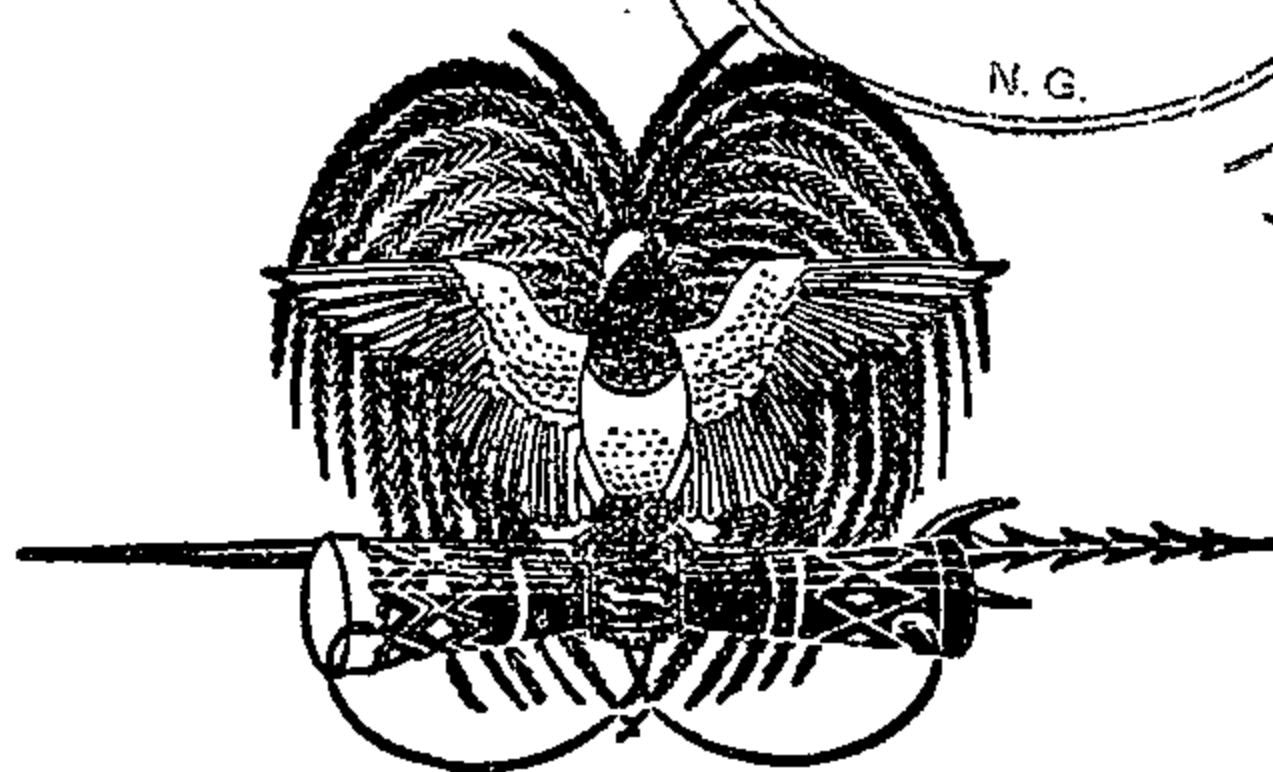

Organic Law on Provincial Government (Amendment) Law

Being a Law to amend the *Organic Law on Provincial Government*.

MADE by the National Parliament to come into operation in accordance with a notice in the *National Gazette* by Head of State, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the Minister.

APPLICATION OF DIVISION 3 (AMENDMENT OF SECTION 24)

The *Organic Law on Provincial Government* is amended—

(a) in Section 24 by repealing paragraphs (c) and (d) from Subsection (1); and

(b) in Section 27 by inserting the following new paragraphs after Paragraph (x):—

“(xa) the sale and distribution of alcoholic liquor; and

“(xb) the control by licensing of public entertainments and of places of public entertainment; and”.
