DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

(a) revoke all previous Determinations of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers; and

(iii) the responsibilities for administering the Act (or part of an Act) specified in Column 3, and set out opposite the name of the Minister,

to come into effect on and from the date of signature of this instrument.
