Central Banking Act (Chapter 138)**Central Banking (Foreign Exchange and Gold) Regulation****GENERAL AUTHORITIES UNDER THE REGULATION**

THE BANK OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA, by virtue of the powers conferred on it by the *Central Banking Act* and the *Central Banking (Foreign Exchange and Gold) Regulation* (the "Regulation"), hereby grants the following general authorities under the Regulation:

1. Exports from Papua New Guinea

(a) Subject to the conditions in paragraph (b) below, general authority is given for the export of goods (other than gold) from Papua New Guinea to a destination in any other country where:

- (i) payment has been received within six months before the date of export; or
- (ii) arrangements have been made for payment to be received within six months after the date of export.

In both instances, the receipt of payment must be in Papua New Guinea currency from an account with a resident bank, or from a bank domiciled outside of Papua New Guinea in any foreign currency.

General Authorities Under The Regulation—continued

(b) This general authority is subject, in each case, to:

- (i) payment in respect of the goods being made in cash representing the whole consideration received or receivable;
- (ii) the sale price of the goods not being less than the price which an exporter from Papua New Guinea might reasonably have expected (regard being had to the terms of the transaction) to obtain for the goods for export to the destination involved at the date when those goods were sold or contracted to be sold;
- (iii) unless otherwise authorised by the Bank of Papua New Guinea, foreign currency proceeds being sold, immediately on receipt, to the Bank of Papua New Guinea or an authorized dealer in Papua New Guinea; and
- (iv) compliance with the administrative procedures set out in Foreign Exchange Control Notice EC6.

2. Export of Currency Notes, Coins, Bills of Exchange etc.

(a) General authority is given for residents of Papua New Guinea travelling to places outside Papua New Guinea to export on their person or in their baggage:

- (i) notes expressed in the currency of Papua New Guinea up to a total of K200 per person; and
- (ii) coins expressed in the currency of Papua New Guinea up to a total of K5 per person; and
- (iii) foreign currency notes and coins up to the equivalent of K10,000 each calendar year, subject to a tax clearance certificate if required.

(b) General authority is given for visitors to Papua New Guinea (being persons who are non resident) to take out any notes, other than notes expressed in Papua New Guinea currency, which they brought in with them.

(c) General authority is given for the export by authorized dealers of foreign currency notes and coins to non-resident correspondent banks for exchange.

(d) General authority is given for the export for collection of bills of exchange, promissory notes and drafts which are expressed in foreign currency and enable the person to whom they are issued to obtain foreign currency, which will be brought into Papua New Guinea and converted into Kina.

3. Inter-company Accounts

General authority is given for any business entity in Papua New Guinea to make payments to, and obtain receipts from, a non resident through the mechanism of inter-company account entries, as an alternative to dealing on a transaction by transaction basis, provided that the entity complies with the requirements set out in Foreign Exchange Control Notice EC 12.

4. Outward Remittance of Foreign Currency

General authority is given for any business entity or adult resident of Papua New Guinea to remit money, or dispose of securities, up to the foreign currency equivalent of K500 000 each calendar year (the "Remittance Allowance") subject to taxation clearance and to compliance with the conditions in Foreign Exchange Control Notice EC20.

5. Dealings in Foreign Securities.

General authority is given for any business entity or adult resident of Papua New Guinea to hold, dispose of or otherwise deal in foreign securities, provided that any disposal of foreign securities is within the Remittance Allowance and is immediately reported to the Bank Papua New Guinea by the person disposing of them or by that person's agent.

6. Export or Import of Gold by Individuals

General authority is given for individuals to export or import on their person small amounts of gold where the total gold content of any article included therein does not exceed the value of K1 000.

Central Banking Act (Chapter 138)

Central Banking (Foreign Exchange and Gold) Regulation

EXEMPTION FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE REGULATION

THE BANK OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA, by virtue of the powers conferred on it by the *Central Banking Act* and the *Central Banking (Foreign Exchange and Gold) Regulation* (the "Regulation"), acting pursuant to Section 3 of the Regulation, hereby exempts the following persons, acts, transactions or securities from the provisions of the Regulation referred to in the respective paragraphs below:

1. Payments for goods of a value below K300 imported into Papua New Guinea are exempt from all relevant provisions of the Regulation.

2. Either:

- (a) the acquisition by a person resident outside Papua New Guinea from a person resident in Papua New Guinea of property of any kind in Papua New Guinea (other than securities); or
- (b) the deposit by a person resident outside Papua New Guinea of funds with a bank or other financial institution resident in Papua New Guinea,

where the value of the property acquired or the amount of the deposit is less than K300, is exempt from all relevant provisions of the Regulation.

3. Exports of:

- (a) goods not exceeding, in any one consignment, a value of K300;
- (b) goods the property of the National Government of Papua New Guinea;
- (c) goods the property of a foreign government used for official purposes by that government in Papua New Guinea;
- (d) stores for consumption on the exporting vessel, vehicle or aircraft and equipment for installation thereon;
- (e) passengers' bona fide baggage, personal effects and household effects, whether accompanied or unaccompanied, where the Commissioner of Customs is satisfied that in any individual case:
 - (i) the total gold content of any article included therein does not exceed a value of K1 000; and
 - (ii) the total value of any of the following goods included therein does not include K10 000 and those goods have been the personal property of the passenger for at least 12 months:
 - (1) industrial diamonds;
 - (2) jewellery;
 - (3) pearls;
 - (4) platinum;
 - (5) precious and semi-precious stones;
 - (6) refined silver;
 - (7) watches with cases of precious metal;
 - (8) works of art;

(f) goods the property of the United Nations or any of its agencies;

(g) goods for the personal or official use of the Diplomatic Corps;

(h) containers previously imported in accordance with the provisions of the Customs Convention on Containers (Geneva 1956) and intended for exportation; and

(i) goods re-exported after display at trade fairs or similar exhibitions where no foreign exchange is involved in the export;

are exempt from Sections 18, 19, 20 and 21 of the Regulation.

Exemption from the Provisions for the Regulation—continued

4. The export of:

- (a) bills of exchange which are expressed in Papua New Guinea currency;
 - (b) bills of exchange which are expressed in foreign currency and issued by an authorized dealer under delegated authority or otherwise with authority from the Bank of Papua New Guinea currency;
 - (c) traveller' cheques, draft, letters of credit, promissory notes or other documents of a similar nature issued by an authorized dealer or otherwise with authority; or
 - (d) travellers' cheques or letters of credit brought in by visitors where they are exported by those visitors;
- is exempted from all relevant provisions of the Regulation.

Designation.—The Geocentric Datum of Papua New Guinea (PNG94).

Reference Ellipsoid.—Geodetic Reference System 1980 (GRS 80) ellipsoid with a semi-major axis (a) of 6 378 137 metres exactly and an inverse flattening (1/f) of 298.257 222 101.

Reference Frame.—The PNG94 is realised by the co-ordinates of the following stations determined from the Australia Fiducial Network (AFN) geodetic stations referred to the GRS80 ellipsoid determined within the International Earth Rotation Service Terrestrial Reference Frame 1992 (ITRF92) at the epoch of 1994.0:
