Prices Regulation Act (Chapter 320)

REVOCATION AND APPOINTMENT OF THE PRICE CONTROLLER AND DEPUTY PRICE CONTROLLER OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA

I, Sir Mekere MORAUTA, Kt. MP., Prime Minister and Minister for Treasury of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 4 and 5 of the *Prices Regulation Act (Chapter 320)* and all other powers me enabling, hereby:—

- (a) revoke the appointment of Dan Salmon Kakaraya as the Price Controller of Papua New Guinea; and
- (b) appoint Koiari Tarata, ISO, as the Price Controller of Papua New Guinea, during his term in office as Secretary for the Department of Treasury; and
- (c) appoint Vali Tavaperry as the Deputy Price Controller of Papua New Guinea, for a period of two (2) years commencing on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the *National Gazette*.
