Customs Tariff Act 1990

EXEMPTION FROM IMPORT DUTY

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(1)(a) of the *Customs Tariff Act 1990*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby, exempt from import duty of materials, supplies, equipments, spare-parts and items which are set out in Schedule 2 of the Project Agreement which are related to the construction of International Five (5) Star Hotel in Port Moresby between the Independent State of Papua New Guinea and the National Capital District Commission and CMSS (PNG) Limited.
