 - Three-fifths in the first period of 15 years of the term;
 - Four-fifths in the first period of 20 years of the term,And during the remainder of the term four-fifths of the land do suitable shall be kept so planted.
- (g) Provided always that if at the end of the two years of the lease it appears that reasonable efforts are not being made to fulfill the improvement conditions, the Minister for Lands & Physical Planning may, by notice in the *National Gazette*, and in accordance with the provisions of the *Land Act* 1996 forfeit the lease.
- (h) Residence Conditions: The lessee or his agent shall take up residence or occupancy of this block within six (6) months from the date of registration of the lease.

AGREEMENT FOR GOVERNANCE OF DELEGATION OF STATUTORY CERTIFICATION SERVICES

This agreement is made on the 11th day of May, 2007.

Between
National Maritime Safety Authority of P.O. Box 1489, Port Moresby, National Capital District (“NMSA”) of the first part;
and
Pacific Register of Ships Limited of P.O. Box 1275, Port Moresby, National Capital District (“PRS”) of the second part;
WHEREAS IT IS HEREBY AGREED AND DECLARED as follows:—

1. Purpose:

1.1 The purpose of this agreement is to delegate authority to perform statutory certification services and to define the scope, terms, conditions and requirements of that delegation.

2. General Conditions:

2.1 Statutory certificate services comprise the assessment of Papua New Guinea registered vessels in order to determine the compliance of such vessels with the applicable requirements of the international conventions, codes and national regulations (hereafter referred to as “applicable instruments”) and the issue of relevant certificates as set out in appendix 1 hereto.

2.2 In so far as the certification services covered by this agreement are concerned, PRS agrees to cooperate with Port State Control officers to facilitate the rectification of reported deficiencies on behalf of NMSA when so requested, and report to NMSA.

2.3 Statutory services rendered and statutory certificates issued by PRDS, in accordance with this agreement, will be accepted as services rendered by or certificates issued by NMSA provided that PRS maintains compliance with the provisions of appendix 1 of the annex to Assembly Resolution A. 739(18).

2.4 Authorisations for services outside the scope of appendix 1 to this agreement will be dealt with, as mutually agreed, on a case-by-case basis.

2.5 PRS shall endeavour to avoid undertaking activities which may result in a conflict of interest.

3. Interpretations, equivalents and exemptions:

3.1 While interpretations of the applicable instruments, as well as the determination of equivalents of the acceptance of substitutes to the requirements of the applicable instruments are the prerogative of NMSA, PRS will cooperate in their establishment as necessary.

3.2 Exemptions from the requirements of the applicable instruments are the prerogative of NMSA and must be approved by NMSA prior to issuance.

Public Notice:—*continued*

- 3.3 In instances where, temporarily, the requirements of an applicable instrument cannot be met under particular circumstances, the PRS surveyor will specify such measures or supplementary equipment as may be available to permit the vessel to proceed to a suitable port where permanent repairs or rectifications can be effected or replacement equipment fitted.
4. Information and Liaison:
 - 4.1 PRS will report to NMSA such information at such frequency as agreed between PRS and NMSA, as delineated in appendix 2 to this agreement.
 - 4.2 NMSA shall be granted access to all plans and documents including reports on surveys on the basis of which certificates are issued or endorsed by PRS.
 - 4.3 NMSA will provide PRS with all necessary documentation for the purpose of PRS's provision of statutory certification services.
 - 4.4 PRS and NMSA, recognizing the importance of technical liaison, agree to cooperate toward this end and maintain an effective dialogue.
 - 4.5 Regulations, rules instruments and report forms shall be available in English.
5. Supervision:
 - 5.1 NMSA will be given the opportunity to satisfy itself that PRS's quality system continues to comply with the requirements of appendix 1 of the annex to Assembly Resolution A.739(18).
 - 5.2 Should NMSA choose to recognize audits performed on PRS by an independent audit group effectively representing the interests of NMSA such as the quality committee of the International Association of Classification Societies.
 - 5.3 Should NMSA choose to conduct direct auditing of PRS, the frequency and extent of audit will be subject to mutual agreement between NMSA and PRS.
6. Other conditions:
 - 6.1 Remuneration.
 - 6.1.1 Remuneration for statutory certification services carried out by PRS on behalf of NMSA will be charged by PRS direct to the party requesting such services.
 - 6.2 Confidentiality.
 - 6.2.1 PRS shall keep in strict confidence and not divulge to a third party any information related to activities performed under this agreement without the prior consent of NMSA.
 - 6.3 Surveyors.
 - 6.3.1 Normally, surveys shall be carried out by surveyors working exclusively for PRS. PRS may use exclusive surveyors of another organisation with which PRS has a bilateral agreement provided that the other organisation is recognised by NMSA. However, PRS may use non-exclusive surveyors provided such surveyors and all services and functions performed by such personnel relevant to this agreement, are subject to the quality assurance system of PRS.

These provisions apply to sub-contractors and to all other suppliers of support services being relevant to statutory survey and certification.
 - 6.4 Amendments.
 - 6.4.1 Amendments to this agreement and appendices will become effective only after consultation and written agreement between NMSA and PRS.
 - 6.5 Governing law and settlement of disputes.
 - 6.5.1 The agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the law of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea. Any dispute arising in connection with this agreement which cannot be settled by the private negotiations between the parties shall be settled finally by arbitration in accordance with the Rules of Conciliation and Arbitration of the International Chamber of Commerce in London.
 - 6.5.2 In the performance of statutory certification services hereunder, PRS, its officers, employees and other acting on its behalf are entitled to all the protections of law and the same defenses and/or counterclaims as would be available to NMSA and its own staff surveyors or employees if the latter had conducted the statutory certification services in question.

6.6 Liability.

6.6.1 In the context of this agreement, if a liability is finally and definitively imposed on NMSA for loss or damage which is proved in a court of law to have been caused by any negligent act or omission by PRS, its officers, employees or others who act on behalf of PRS under this agreement, NMSA is entitled to seek from PRS compensation up to the amount of financial liability as defined in standard terms and conditions of PRS.

6.6.2 While acting for NMSA under this agreement, PRS shall be free to create contracts direct with its clients and such contracts may contain PRS's normal contractual conditions for limiting its legal liability.

6.7 Termination.

6.7.1 If this agreement is breached by one of the parties, the other party will not notify the violating party of its breach in writing to allow the notified party the opportunity to remedy the breach within 180 days, failing which the notifying party has the right to terminate the agreement immediately.

6.7.2 This agreement may be terminated by either party by giving the other party 12 months written notice.
