## CONSTITUTION

### REVOCATION OF THE REMOVAL OF CHIEF JUSTICE FROM OFFICE

I, Sir Michael Ogio, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 179 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby:—

- (a) revoke the appointment of a Tribunal under Section 181 of the Constitution for the purpose of removal of the Chief Justice; and
- (b) revoke the appointment of Paul Akuram (a former judge) as Chairman of the Tribunal and Collin Makail and George Manuhu (current judges) as members of the Tribunal; and
- (c) withdraw the referral made under Section 179(1)(b) of the Constitution to the Tribunal appointed under Section 181 of the Constitution,

as published in the *National Gazette* No. G316 of 10th November, 2011, commencing on and from 14th November, 2011.

### REVOCATION OF THE SUSPENSION OF CHIEF JUSTICE FROM OFFICE

- (b) Section 169 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Minister responsible for the national justice administration, hereby revoke the notice of appointment of Justice Gibbs Salika as Acting Chief Justice,
