DECLARATION OF A PORT—BASAMUK PORT, RAICOAST, MADANG PROVINCE

I, Garry Juffa, Commissioner of Customs, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by Section 7(1)(b) of the *Customs Act* (Chapter 101 as amended) and all other powers enabling me, for the purposes of the *Customs Act* and its related legislation, hereby appoint the place described in Schedule 1 of this instrument and more specifically shown on the sketch annexed hereto, as a limited Port for the purposes specified in Schedule 2.

SCHEDULE 1

All that part of area located at the west of Basamuk Bay. The landmark is No.1 light beacon, the correspondent WGS84 geographical coordinates is, south latitude 5 degrees 32 minutes 16.6 seconds; east longitude 146 degrees 8 minutes 16.4 seconds. It starts from the south-east 55 degrees 9 minutes 7.1 seconds of No.1 light beacon 233.88 meters to the north corner of the Basamuk Port 50000 DWT Wharf, then south-west 11 degrees 20 minutes 54.5 seconds 67.50 meters then north-east 78 degrees 39 minutes 6.3 seconds 41.00 meters then south-west 70 degrees 2 minutes 44.1 seconds 55.90 meters then due west 85 meters then due south 115.44 meters then due east 85 meters then due south 58.91 meters then south-east 78 degrees 37 minutes 30.8 seconds 54.41 meters then south-west 11 degrees 20 minutes 53.9 seconds 67.50 meters then south-east 78 degrees 39 minutes 8.2 seconds 8.00 meters then north-east 11 degrees 20 minutes 53.9 seconds 55.00 meters then south-east 78 degrees 36 minutes 49.7 seconds 51.50 metres then north-east 11 degrees 20 minutes 53.7 seconds 225.00 meters then north-west 78 degrees 39 minutes 5.9 seconds 51.50 meters then north-east 11 degrees 20 minutes 54.1 seconds 55.00 meters then north-west 78 degrees 39 minutes 8.2 seconds 8.00 meters to the north-west corner of the waters of area which is known as the Basamuk Port Area.

SCHEDULE 2

The port is for the exclusive use during the project timeframe by Ramu Nico Management (MCC), its contractors, subcontractors and suppliers for import of project cargo and related consignments and export of minerals extracted from the Ramu Nickel project.

The appointment of this port has effect from 1st of November, 2011 and may be revoked by a subsequent notice.
