CONSTITUTION**CALL-OUT OF THE PAPUA NEW GUINEA DEFENCE FORCE TO ASSIST POLICE AND HUMANITARIAN AGENCIES TO ADMINISTER RELIEF ASSISTANCE TO LAND SLIP VICTIMS OF KOMO DISTRICT AND TO PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO ADDRESS LAW AND ORDER SITUATIONS IN TARI AND HELA REGIONS OF THE SOUTHERN HIGHLANDS PROVINCES**

I, Sir Michael Ogio, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 20 of the *Defence Force Act 1974* and Section 204 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby call out the Papua New Guinea Defence Force to assist the—
