Migration Act (Chapter 16)

EXEMPTION

I, Rimbink Pato, Minister for Foreign Affairs and Immigration, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 20 of the *Migration Act* (Chapter 16), and all other powers me enabling, hereby:—

- (a) revoke the notice of exemption dated 2nd September, 2012 and as published in the *National Gazette* No. G334 of 5th September, 2012; and
- (b) exempt transferees who travel to Papua New Guinea under the terms of the Memorandum of Understanding Between the Government of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea and the Government of Australia Relating to the Transfer to and Assessment of Persons in Papua New Guinea, and Related Issues, signed on 8th September, 2012 under the following provisions of the Act -
 - (i) entry permit under Section 3 of the *Migration Act* (Chapter 16); and
 - (ii) unlawful presence under Section 7 of the Act.

Migration Act (Chapter 16)

DIRECTION TO RESIDE IN RELOCATION CENTRE

I, Rimbink Pato, Minister for Foreign Affairs and Immigration, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 15C of the *Migration Act* (Chapter 16), and all other powers me enabling, hereby:—

- (a) revoke the notice of Direction to Reside in a Relocation Centre dated 2nd September, 2012 and as published in the *National Gazette* No. G334 of 5th September, 2012; and
- (b) direct all persons seeking international refugee protection and who are permitted to enter and reside in Papua New Guinea under the terms of the Memorandum of Understanding Between the Government of the Independent State of Papua New Guinea and the Government of Australia Relating to the Transfer to and Assessment of Persons in Papua New Guinea, and Related Issues, signed on 8th September, 2012 to temporarily reside at the Relocation Centre located at the Papua New Guinea Naval Base in Lombrum, Manus Province for the purposes of the determination of their refugee status.

DECLARATION OF RELOCATION CENTRE

I, Rimbink Pato, Minister for Foreign Affairs and Immigration, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 15B of the *Migration Act* (Chapter 16), and all other powers me enabling, hereby:—

- (a) revoke the notice of Declaration of Relocation Centre dated 2nd September, 2012 and as published in the *National Gazette* No. G334 of 5th September, 2012; and
- (b) declare the Regional Processing Centre located at the Papua New Guinea Naval Base in Lombrum, Manus Province to be a Relocation Centre for the Temporary Residence of Asylum Seekers pending the determination of their refugee status.
