NOTICE PURSUANT TO CLAUSE 1.4(ii) OF THE PNG PORTS REGULATORY CONTRACT ("CONTRACT")

I, Billy Manoka, Commissioner and CEO of the Independent Consumer & Competition Commission ("ICCC"), by virtue of the powers conferred to me by the *Independent Consumer and Competition Commission Act 2002* and Clause 1.4(ii) of the above Contract entered into between the ICCC and PNG Ports Corporation Limited ("PNG Ports") and all other powers enabling me, hereby approve the following tariffs as the approved tariffs to be applied by PNG Ports for its regulated essential port services for the 2013 regulatory year.

5. TRANSHIPMENTS

The tariffs for transhipments (inward and outward charged separately) will be charged at, for overseas—50%, and for coastal—100%, of the respective approved wharfage tariffs in accordance with Schedule 1, Part A of this Contract, and payable at the port of transhipment.

The above tariffs shall come into effect on the 28th January, 2013.
