Consolidated Contractors (PNG) Company Limited is a contracting company to the PNG LNG Project and wishes to engage the services of experienced non-citizens who are required urgently in the Construction Phase of the LNG Project. The company is engaged in the construction of the Komo Airfield in Southern Highlands and the LNG Main Plant Buildings at the Motukea Site, Port Moresby.

- (3) For the company to provide employment opportunities (decent work, fair pay, promotions etc) to citizen workers;
- (4) For the company to provide opportunities for human resource development and skills training to its employees;
- (5) Non English speaking countries to show evidence of English proficiency for applicants.
