AMENDMENT OF DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

I, Peter O'Neill, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby amend the Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers dated 10th August, 2012 and published in the *National Gazette* No. G304 dated 10th August, 2012 (as amended) —

Amendment of Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers—*continued*

(a) in Schedule 6 (Minister for Transport) —

- (i) by deleting the title “Minister for Transport” and inserting “Minister for Transport and Infrastructure”; and
- (ii) in Column 1, by deleting Malakai Tabar and inserting William Duma; and
- (iii) in Column 2, by deleting the title “Minister for Transport” and inserting “Minister for Transport and Infrastructure”; and

(b) in Schedule 10 (Minister for Religion, Youth and Community Development), Column 1, by deleting Loujaya Toni and inserting Delilah Gore; and

(c) in Schedule 12 (Minister for Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology), Column 1, by deleting Delilah Gore and inserting Malakai Tabar.
