## PUBLIC NOTICE

I, **GRAND CHIEF SIR BOB DADAE**, GCL., G.C.M.G., K. St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the *Public Holidays Act* (Chapter 321) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby—

- (a) appoint Monday 8th June, 2020 to be the day to commemorate the birthday of the Queen; and
- (b) appoint Wednesday 16th September, 2020 to be the day to commemorate the attainment of Independent Sovereign Nationhood; and
- (c) appoint Thursday 23rd July, 2020 to be the day to Commemorate the PNG Remembrance Day; and
- (d) for general information notify that the following days shall be observed as Public Holidays throughout Papua New Guinea:—
