**Having heard** Mr. Marahare of Counsel for the Claimants

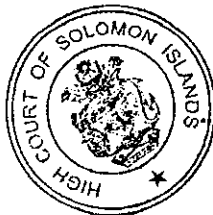
**And having heard** Mr. Muria (Jnr) of Counsel for the 1<sup>st</sup> Defendant
