CONSTITUTION (AMENDMENT) (CANDIDACY DISQUALIFICATION) ACT 2023

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the *Constitution (Amendment) (Candidacy Disqualification) Act 2023*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the day appointed by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*.

3 Section 49 amended

Section 49 is amended:

- (a) at the end of subsection 1(f), omit “or”; and
- (b) at the end of subsection (1)(g), replace the full stop with a semicolon and add “or”; and
- (c) insert a new subsection (1)(h):

“(h) is also a candidate for election as a member of a Provincial Assembly or of the Honiara City Council where the election of members of Parliament, members of Provincial Assemblies and members of the Honiara City Council are conducted at the same date and time.”.
