**HONIARA CITY ACT 1999**  
(Act No. 2 of 1999)

**HONIARA CITY COUNCIL (2011 APPROPRIATION) ORDER 2010**

**WHEREAS** pursuant to sections 6 and 9 of the Honiara City Act, the election of members of the Honiara City Council was due to have been held on 27 August 2010 after the Council was dissolved at midnight on 26 August 2010 on the expiration of the term of four years of the Council after the last election;

**WHEREAS** the holding of the general elections for National Parliament during the same period did prevent or hinder the holding of the election on 27 August 2010, as required under the Honiara City Act;

**WHEREAS** the next election of members of the Honiara City Council is due to be held on 8 December 2010 (Legal Notice 137 of 2010);

**WHEREAS** to ensure the proper functioning of Honiara City Council, estimates of the revenue and expenditure of the Council for the 2011 financial year must be approved and related Ordinances enacted by the Council by 1 January 2011;

**WHEREAS** there will be insufficient time for new members of Honiara City Council to approve such estimates and enact such Ordinances;

**I THEREFORE** make this Order pursuant to section 72 of the Act due to the unforeseen and special circumstances set out in the recitals above –

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Honiara City Council (2011 Appropriation) Order 2010 and commences on 1 January 2011.

(2) This Order may be replaced by an Appropriation Ordinance made by the new Council.

2. (1) The issue from the City Fund of a sum of \$23,846,804 (Twenty Three Million, Eight Hundred and Forty-Six Thousand and Eight Hundred and Four Dollars) is authorised, to be applied to the service of the year ending 31 December 2011.

(2) The sum specified in subparagraph (1) shall be appropriated for the supply of the heads specified, and in the amounts respectively specified in relation to such heads, in the Schedule.

(3) The 2011 Estimates of revenue and expenditure are deemed to have been laid before the City Council and recommended by the respective Standing Committee.
