**SOLOMON ISLANDS INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1978
(L.N. 43 of 1978)**

**ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY TO THE
PRIME MINISTER**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 37 of the Constitution and in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, I, **SIR FRANK UTU OFAGIORO KABUI**, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Cross of the Order of Solomon Islands, Officer of the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands hereby –

- (a) assign to the person from time to time holding the office of:

the responsibility for the administration of the Office of the Prime Minister and Cabinet and for the conduct of the business of the Government of Solomon Islands as set out in the Schedule -
