**THE SOLOMON ISLANDS INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1978  
(LN No. 43 of 1978)**

**TO: ROMANO SADAKAVOLOMO OF ROVE, CENTRAL  
PRISON, HONIARA, SOLOMON ISLANDS**

**PARDON**

WHEREAS you were convicted of the crime of murder by the High Court of Solomon Islands and sentenced to life imprisonment on 25 July 1972.

AND WHEREAS your petition for clemency/mercy was considered and accepted by the Committee on the Prerogative of Mercy during its meeting on the 14th December 1995.

NOW THEREFORE in accordance with the recommendation of the said Committee and in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by section 45(1)(a) of the Constitution, I, MOSES PUIBANGARA PITAKAKA Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight of Saint John, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands, do hereby grant you a FREE PARDON, with effect from the date hereof.
