THE WHARVES ACT

(Chapter 138)

ORDER IN COUNCIL

In exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 5 and 16 of the Wharves Act (Chapter 138), as amended, His Majesty the King, with the advice and consent of His Privy Council hereby alters and adds to the rates specified in Schedules A and B of that Act by omitting the particulars set out in those Schedules and inserting in their stead the particulars set out in the Schedule hereto, and further orders and declares that this Order in Council shall have effect from the date of publication in the Gazette.

THE STAMP ACT

(Chapter 70)

RESOLUTION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 3 of the Stamp Act (Cap.70), as amended, His Majesty the King, with the advice and consent of His Privy Council hereby adds to, alters and amends the duties payable under the Stamp Act by deleting the Schedule and replacing it with the following Schedule and further resolves that this resolution shall have effect from the date of publication in the Gazette.
