PROCLAMATION

INTERPRETATION ACT

(Section 20)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Interpretation Act (Cap. 1), as amended, His Majesty in Council hereby PROCLAIMS as follows:

1. The standard time throughout the Kingdom shall revert to be 13 hours in advance of Greenwich Mean Time at all times.
2. The Proclamation published in the Tonga Government Gazette Supplement Extraordinary No. 7 of 13 October, 2000 is hereby repealed.
