**CUSTOMS ACT 2007
(Section 3(1) (b))**

ORDER

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3(1)(b) of the Customs Act 2007, the Minister responsible for Revenue and Customs, with the approval of Cabinet, makes the following Order:

- (1) The importation of bitumen for all government road works in Tonga shall be exempt from import duty.
- (2) Any exemption of import duty to be processed by the Ministry of Revenue and Customs for bitumen shall be subject to the importer obtaining certification from the Chief Executive Officer of the Ministry of Infrastructure of the actual bill of quantities eligible to exemption.

**CONSUMPTION TAX ACT 2003
(Section 5(3)(a))**

ORDER

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 5(3)(a) of the Consumption Tax Act 2003, the Minister responsible for Revenue and Customs, with the approval of Cabinet makes the following Order:

- (1) The importation of bitumen for all government road works shall be exempted from consumption tax.
- (2) Any exemption of import consumption tax for bitumen to be processed by the Ministry of Revenue and Customs shall be subject to the importer obtaining certification from the Chief Executive Officer of the Ministry of Infrastructure of the actual bill of quantities eligible to exemption.
