EXCISE TAX ACT [CAP 11.04]

(Section 3(1)(c))

ORDER

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3(1)(c) of the Excise Tax Act [CAP 11.04], the Minister responsible for revenue and customs, with the approval of Cabinet makes the following Order –

- (1) That all imports of food items and personal consumer goods not for commercial purposes shall be exempted from excise tax;
- (2) That this Order shall come into force on the date of gazettal; and
- (3) That this Order shall expire on 31 March 2021.
