- To be under the supervision of Chief Maseipokasi as his Community Justice Supervisor.
- To undertake counseling with the pastor of his Church.
- Not to indirectly or directly contact the victim.
- Not to Consume Alcohol or Drugs during Parole Sentence.
- Must perform a custom reconciliation.

- To be supervised by your presiding chief as appointed by your Probation officer as the Community Justice Supervisor.
- You must not leave the country to seasonal scheme unless completing your parole sentence.
- You must not communicate with your victim, her families without prior approval from your Probation Officers.

- Not to consume alcohol
- To undertake counselling with the Pastor of his church.
