LAND DECLARATION

The land boundaries is described to commence from the north of the Airstrip, through Title no. 346 to Bonowoi on the east running down on a parallel line to the end of the airport and Venenenvo in the south, and follows the hill of Lamango to Nantak to the sea at western side and running up to the end of the airport on the north. For more specification, see map contained here in file.

Upon being satisfied that the extension of 30 days of publicity has expired by virtue of the order dated 6th May, 2004 there is no registration of counter claim. As such, the subject land remains undisputed. Therefore, in application of section 11 of the Island Court's Act, Cap 167; IT IS HEREBY THIS DAY DECLARED THAT Family Thompson Massing Lebis is the custom owner of Alo land accordingly.

Having pronounced this declaration, it is further ordered;


1. That all persons working the declared land must undertake to make proper arrangements with the declared owner for their continuous use of the land.
2. That all disputants of the land are restrained from interfering in all manners with owner's right of enjoyment over the land.
3. That any party wishing to challenge this decision may do so, in a period 60 days from date.
