JUDGMENT

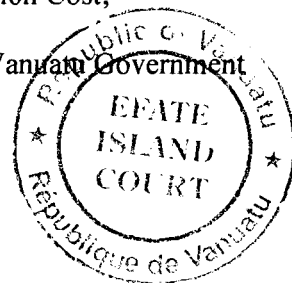
The defendants, Wilson Aru Ray, is charged with the offence and pleaded guilty to the charges of **IDLE AND DISORDERLY**, against section 148(b), Penal Code Act Cap 135 and **ABUSIVE LANGUAGE** contrary to Section 121 of the Penal Code Act Cap 135.

The facts provided by the prosecutor states that on the 15th of April 2017, at Fresh Water 3 road, the defendant of this case namely Wilson Aru Ray was totally under the influence of alcohol liquor and cannot control himself. Therefore he acted in a disorderly manner and insult the complainant of this case namely Naomie Laicha where this place is a Public Place.

Having heard the evidence provided by the Prosecutor and defense statement made by the defendant;

The Court is satisfied and hereby makes the following Orders:

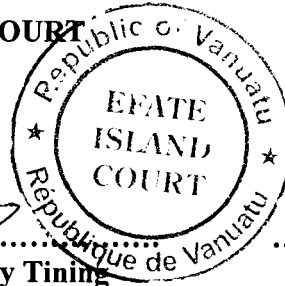
1. The Court orders Wilson Aru Ray, the Defendant to pay 2'000vt as Island Court Fine;
2. The Defendant Wilson Aru Ray is also ordered to pay and 1'000vt as Prosecution Cost;
3. All Payment must be made before the 15th day of March 2018 directly to the Vanuatu Government Cashier and copy of payment receipt to be shown at the Efate Island Court;



4. If either parties do not agree with the Judgement within 30 days upon receiving judgment have the right to appeal to the Magistrate Court.
