COURT JUDGMENT

An application has been filed by **Aaron Richard Collin** who is the plaintiff before this court in pursuant to Rule 1(2) of the Island Court Procedure Rules of 2005.

This is a normal civil claim for breach of contract between the Claimant and the Defendant namely **Tanearu Joseph Taty**.

Both parties were summoned and served. This matter was supported in open court.

Having read, heard and considered the application of claim made by the Claimant in this matter Aaron Richard Collin on behalf of his unpaid sum;

And having heard and considered the Defendant's response concerning the debt Vt 35'000 which is the subject of this Court;

Both parties agreed that the outstanding Vatu for the Court to deal with is now reduced to Vt 33'000.

This Court is satisfied and hereby makes the following Orders:

1. The Court orders that the Defendant 'Tanearu Joseph Taty' to pay Vt 33'000 by monthly instalment of Vt 5'000 commencing end of March 2018;
2. All monthly payments to be made directly to Mr. Aaron Richard Collin, the claimant,



3. Mr. Aaron Richard Collin is ordered to produce payment receipt to the defendant once payment received;
4. Both parties need to respect and comply with these orders. Failure to the above, party may apply orally or in writing to the Supervising Magistrate for Enforcement of the order or judgment if it remains unsatisfied.
5. Parties have right to appeal from that judgment to the Magistrate's Court within 30 days from the date of this judgement.
