This twenty second day of July one thousand nine hundred and thirteen in the matter of a charge against Theo Thomas of Santo of having recruited the native labourers Charlie, Toom, and Armool at Maewo on the 16th. of October 1911 on board the cutter Phyllis without having the recruiting license provided for by Article XXXI of the New Hebrides Convention.

The Joint Court having heard the evidence for the prosecution and for the defence acquits the said Theo Thomas.
