THE PUBLIC PROSECUTOR V WILLIAM HERMAN GRUBE.

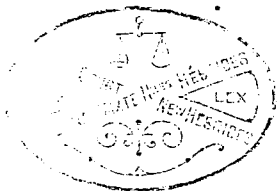
This twenty-second day of September 1916,
