In the matter of a charge against Kim Sam, Chinese, Engineer and Storekeeper of Vila.

The above named Kim Sam stands convicted before the Joint Court for that he at Vila aforesaid did sell by retail certain wines, beer and spirits from his premises at Vila aforesaid without a licence contrary to the provisions Art. 8 of the Joint Regulations of the 16th March 1916.

Thereupon the Joint Court sentences the said Kim Sam for his said offence to pay a fine of frs 500, and further to pay the amount of a licence for the whole of the current year; and further to pay the costs of the prosecution.
