

This twenty first day of November one thousand nine hundred and thirteen in the matter of a charge against A.R. Johns of Tongoa.

The above named A. R Johns stands convicted in default of appearance before the Joint Court for that he did on or about the 21st. September 1913 at Nongarese Tongoa sell to one Jack Musoorang native of Tongoa aforesaid one Winchester rifle contrary to the provisions of Article LVII of the Convention.

Thereupon the Joint Court sentences the said A.R. Johns for his said offence to pay a penalty of two pounds (£2) and the costs of these proceedings and orders the confiscation of the rifle.
