JOINT REGULATION

No. 7 of
1969.

To bring into effect the Estimates of the Joint Administration for the year 1969.

Published: Condominium Gazette No. 277.]

MADE by the British and French Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 5, 7, paragraph 2 of the Joint Finance Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and Section 5 of the Joint Finance Regulation No. 10 of 1957, after consultation with the Advisory Council and with the approval of the Governments of Her Majesty and the French Republic.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the 1969 Appropriation Joint Regulation.

2. The Estimates of the Joint Administration of the year 1969 shall provide for—

- (a) Révenue for the amount of one million three hundred and twenty-nine thousand eight hundred and fifteen pounds sterling (£Stg. 1,329,815) or two hundred and eighty-five million nine hundred and ten thousand six hundred and sixty New Hebrides francs (285,910,660 FNH).
- (b) Expenditure to the amount of one million three hundred and twenty-nine thousand eight hundred and fifteen pounds sterling (£Stg. 1,329,815) or two hundred and eighty-five million nine hundred and ten thousand, six hundred and sixty New Hebrides Francs (285,910,660 FNH).

3. There shall be issued from General Revenue and other funds of the Joint Administration and applied to the Service of the year ending December 1969 a sum not exceeding that specified in subsection (b) of section 2 of this Regulation. The said amount shall be appropriated as set out in the Schedule to this Regulation.

The Resident Commissioners may jointly authorise the Comptroller and the Condominium Treasurer to control expenditure each according to his responsibilities as set out in Joint Standing Order No. 4 of 1957 within the limits fixed by such authorisation; the sums shall not exceed on the whole the sum specified in subsection (b) of Section 2 of this Regulation.
