JOINT REGULATION

provide for the prevention of damage to and interference with Government property.

made by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 2 and Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Any person who shall wilfully and unlawfully damage, destroy, deface, mutilate, remove or in any way interfere with any Government property shall commit an offence punishable upon conviction by imprisonment for a term not exceeding one year or by a fine not exceeding five hundred Australian dollars or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Offences.

2. For the purposes of this regulation, and without prejudice to the generality of its meaning, the expression "Government property"—

Interpreta-
tion.

(i) shall include all boundary or survey markers, posts, pegs, flags or signs, all traffic signs or notices, and all other equipment or property owned by or on behalf of the French or British National Administrations or the Joint Administration, or placed or affixed in any place by any officer, servant or agent of any of the said Administrations in pursuance of or in connection with the official business of such Administration;

(ii) shall be deemed to include all materials and equipment whatsoever used in the operation of authorised public services and utilities.

Any person found by an officer or member of the police committing an offence against the foregoing provisions of this regulation, shall be taken without delay before the District Agent of the nationality of the offender or, in the case of a native, before the District Agent of the Power controlling the division of the police to which the officer or member belongs. The District Agent in charge shall immediately put in train the procedure laid down for offences by the Order of the Joint Court made on the 29th April,

4. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Protection of Government Property Regulation No. 13 of 1970 and shall come into force on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
