oint Regulation No. 5 of 1963 was published in Condominium Gazette 3, 218 and is reprinted as amended by Joint Regulation No. 11 of 16 (Gazette No. 304). See also Joint Regulation No. 1 of 1955.]

[1. Any person or group of persons (hereinafter referred to as a applicant") being the owner or occupier of any real property frequiring such property to be connected to the public water apply may apply in writing to the Superintendent of Public Works vila or to the District Engineer at Santo or Tanna, as the case be.]

- 2. Subject to technical and material practicability the Public iks Department shall connect the property of the applicant to water supply system on payment by him of the cost of any essary extension from the water mains to the property to be ed; provided that no charge shall be made where the length of extension does not exceed ten metres.
- The extension shall end at the boundary of the property to eved at which point shall be placed the water meter of the Public S Department. Any part of the supply system between the mains and the meter shall thereafter be deemed to belong to ublic Works Department and any part beyond the meter the party of the applicant.
- The cost of extension shall be calculated on the basis of the cost of labour and materials used in the extension and any lions required to the supply system to permit the extension; amount shall be added a surcharge of 25% to cover the cost servision and overheads.

Before work on the extension is commenced the applicant deposit with the Condominium Treasury an amount equal to of the estimated cost of extension as assessed by the Public Department. The applicant shall pay the balance within three has of the extension being completed, the date of completion notified to the applicant by the Superintendent of Public in writing.

In the event of the applicant failing to complete payment the prescribed time the Public Works Department may, withpludice to the recovery of any amount due for labour used, therefore the property and recover the materials used in the

- Before work is commenced on any extension estimated to more than £Stg. 50 or its equivalent in francs NH at the current of exchange the applicant may be required to produce a bank fantee or other acceptable security equal to the amount payable completion of the extension.
- If ownership of the property changes hands before the cost dension is paid by the applicant the liability for any balance due remain with the applicant until the new owner of the property ats liability in writing and produces security to the satisfaction he Superintendent of Public Works to replace any security given the preceding section. On completion of payment any rights the extension arising under section 9 of this Joint Regulation the deemed to belong to the owner of the property served by such ision.
- For a period of 5 years after the date of completion of any sion no other person shall be connected thereto unless authorin writing by the owner or owners of the property or properties hich the connection was made under the provisions of Section 2 is Joint Regulation.
