JOINT REGULATION

No. 6 of 1937.

We, His Britannic Majesty's Resident Commissioner and the Resident Commissioner for the French Republic in the New Hebrides DO HEREBY MAKE the following Joint Regulation:

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| <p>1. Joint Regulation No. 5 of 1936 is hereby repealed.</p> | <p>Repeal.</p> |
| <p>2. Every person having the charge or control of an animal whose death has been caused by tetanus shall forthwith thereafter completely incinerate the carcase thereof, and shall then disinfect the site of such incineration with a 5 per centum solution of chloride of lime or of cresyl.</p> | <p>Destruction etc., of carcase.</p> |
| <p>3. Such incineration and destruction may be carried out by the Condominium at the request of the person concerned, who shall pay the cost of the materials and labour involved.</p> | <p>Power of Condominium.</p> |
| <p>4. Any person committing a breach of this Regulation shall be liable to a fine of not less than one pound (124 francs) nor more than twenty pounds sterling (2,480 francs).</p> | <p>Penalty.</p> |
| <p>5. This Regulation shall come into force on the date hereof and may be cited as the "New Hebrides Tetanus Regulation No. 6 of 1937".</p> | <p>Date of Coming into Force and Short Title.</p> |
