A JOINT REGULATION

No. 5 of 1929.

define the limits of the town of Vila.

Regulation No. 5 of 1929 was published in Condominium Gazette No. 30 and is reprinted with the following Joint Regulations, which amend and amend it.

Limits defined.

1. From the date of the coming into force of this Regulation the limits of the town of Vila, which shall include the island of Iririki, fixed as follows—

On the West, by the sea;

On the South, and East, by the Colardeau plantation;

On the North (1) by a cliff which divides the Condominium terrain from the Colardeau plantation; (2) by the Southern and Western boundary of the Rossi plantation; (3) by the Northern boundary of the French Hospital lands running East and West to the Tagabe road; (4) by the Tagabe road up to its junction with the Anabrou road; (5) by the Anabrou road for a distance of approximately 370 metres and, (6) then by a line running East and West for approximately 125 metres ending in the sea.

2. A plan of the town of Vila setting out the limits herein defined shall form an annex to the present Regulation.

3. This Regulation shall be cited for all purposes as the "New Vila Town Limits Regulation No. 5 of 1929," and shall come into force on the date of publication.
