LOCAL GOVERNMENT (AMENDMENT) REGULATION

1980

Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Regulation is to extend the term of office of members of Port Vila Municipal Council and Community Councils while a new law is being prepared.

Although the extension is until the 30th November 1980 the Government hopes that before that time there will be a new law and new elections can be held.
