

NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

JOINT REGULATION

No. 32 of 1976

TO PROHIBIT the sale of alcoholic liquor in the Santo urban and Santo-Malo-Aore rural constituencies.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

Prohibition
and sale of
liquor

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Joint Liquor Licensing Regulation No. 18 of 1968 as amended, the sale and supply of alcoholic liquor at licensed premises within the Santo urban and Santo-Malo-Aore rural constituencies, whether for consumption on or off the premises, is hereby prohibited from midday on Saturday the 23rd day of October 1976 until the normal hours of opening of such licensed premises on Sunday the 31st day of October 1976.

Provided that alcoholic liquor may be sold during the said period within the normal hours of opening in restaurants to bona fide customers for consumption with their meals.

Power of
District
Agent's to
suspend
prohibition

2. The provisions of section 1 may be suspended by the District Agents before the expiry of the period of prohibition, whether in whole or in part and whether in one or other of the said constituencies or both, if they consider that the circumstances so permit.

3. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Liquor Licensing (Special Provisions) Regulation No. 32 of 1976 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
