

NEW HEBRIDES CONDOMINIUM

JOINT REGULATION

No. 44 of 1975

TO PROVIDE for the registration as electors of certain persons temporarily resident abroad.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and of Article 3 (1) (b) of the Schedule to the Exchange of Notes between the Governments of the United Kingdom and the French Republic made at Paris on the 29th day of August, 1975.

Registration of certain electors temporarily resident abroad

1. Any student or worker temporarily resident abroad during any part whatever of the period of three years immediately preceding the 10th day of November, 1975 who in all other respects fulfils the conditions to be qualified for registration as an elector of the representatives of the people under the provisions of Article 3 (1) (a) of the Schedule to the Exchange of Notes between the Governments of the United Kingdom and the French Republic made at Paris on the 29th day of August 1975 shall if he or she returns to reside in the New Hebrides on or before the date of closure of the electoral rolls, be entitled to be so registered as an elector.

Citation and commencement

2. This Regulation may be cited as the Representative Assembly (Special Provisions) Regulation No. 44 of 1975 and shall upon its publication in the Condominium Gazette be deemed to have come into operation on the 29th day of August, 1975.
